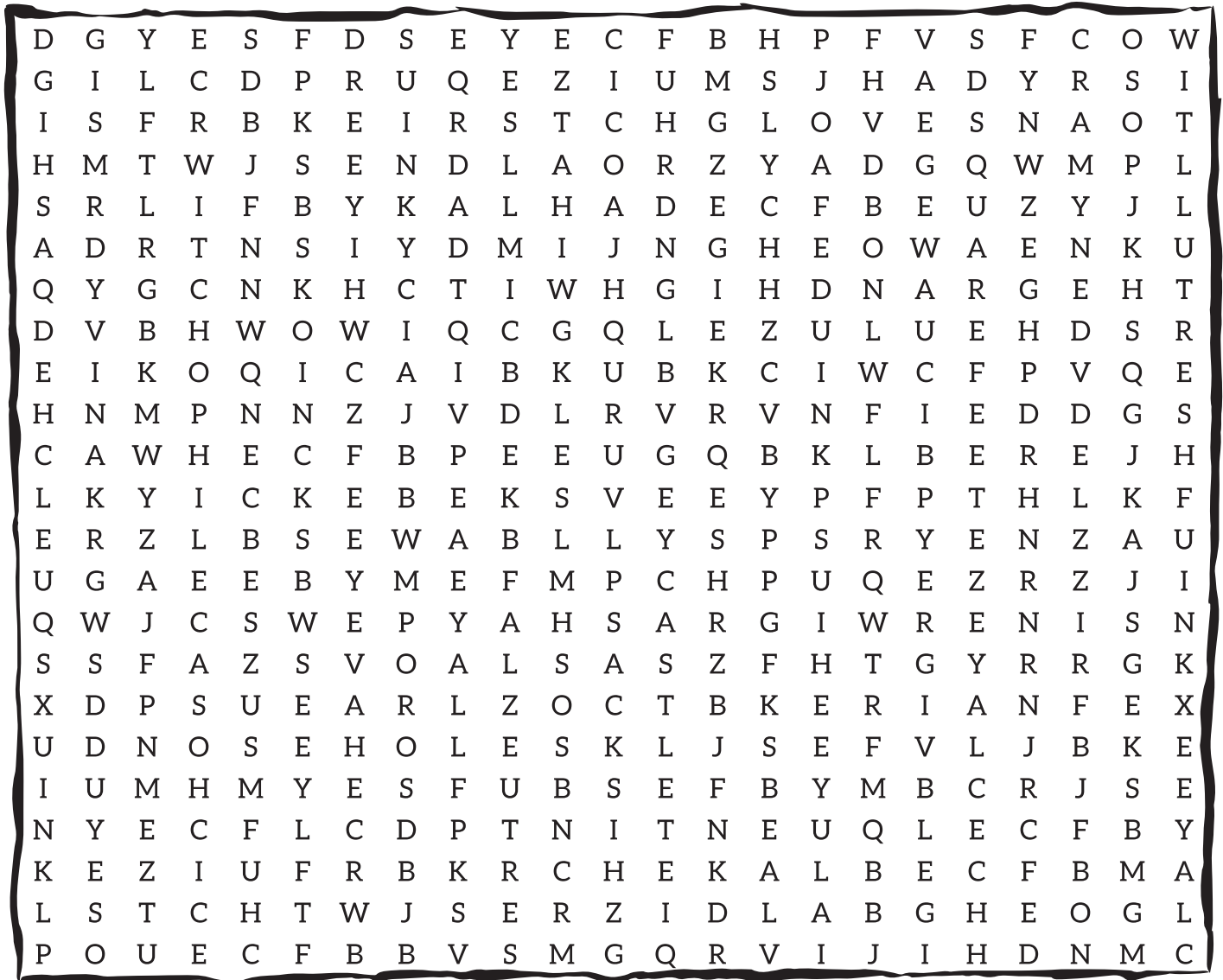

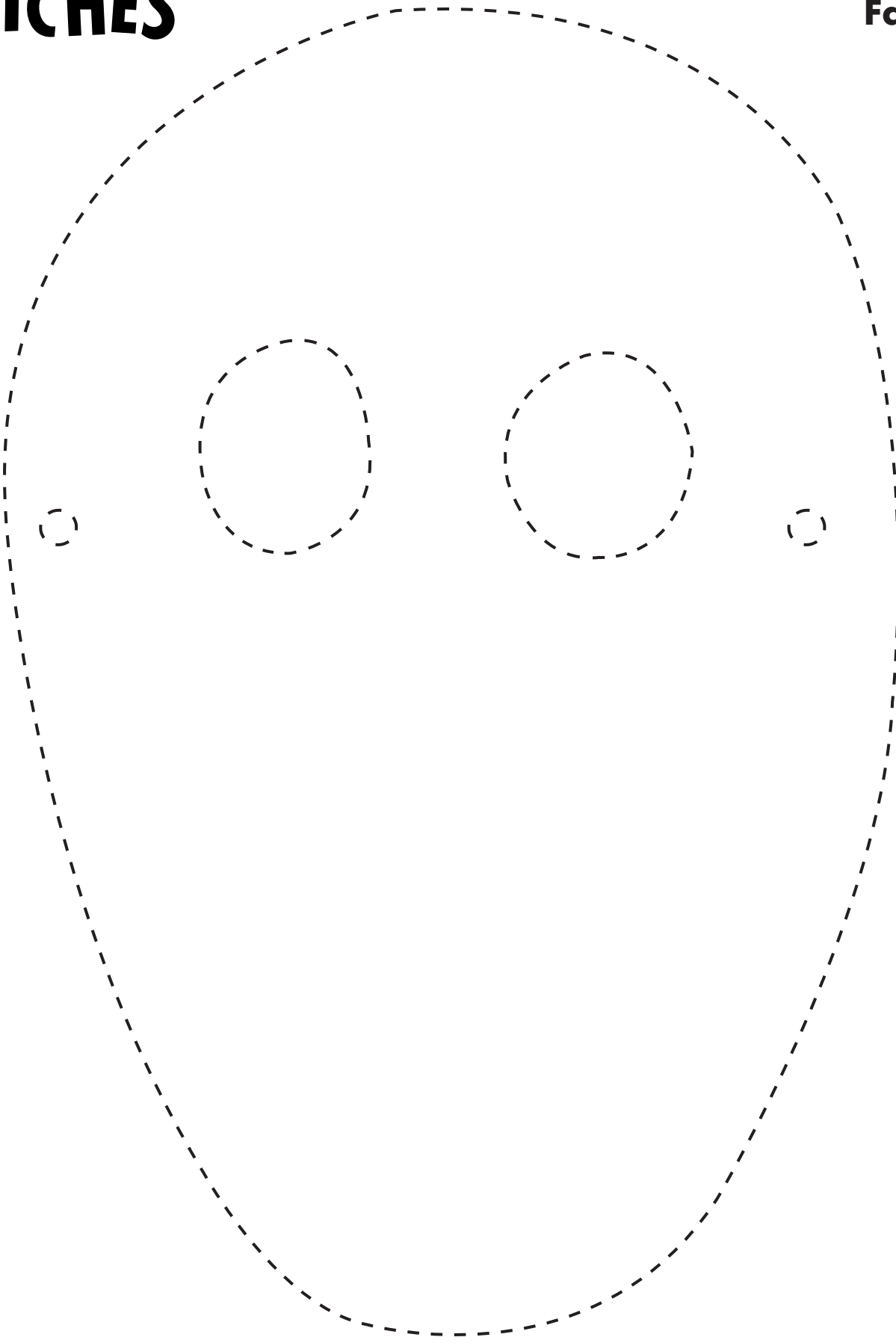
Use the masks on the next two pages to disguise yourself as The Grand High Witch—with either of her faces!

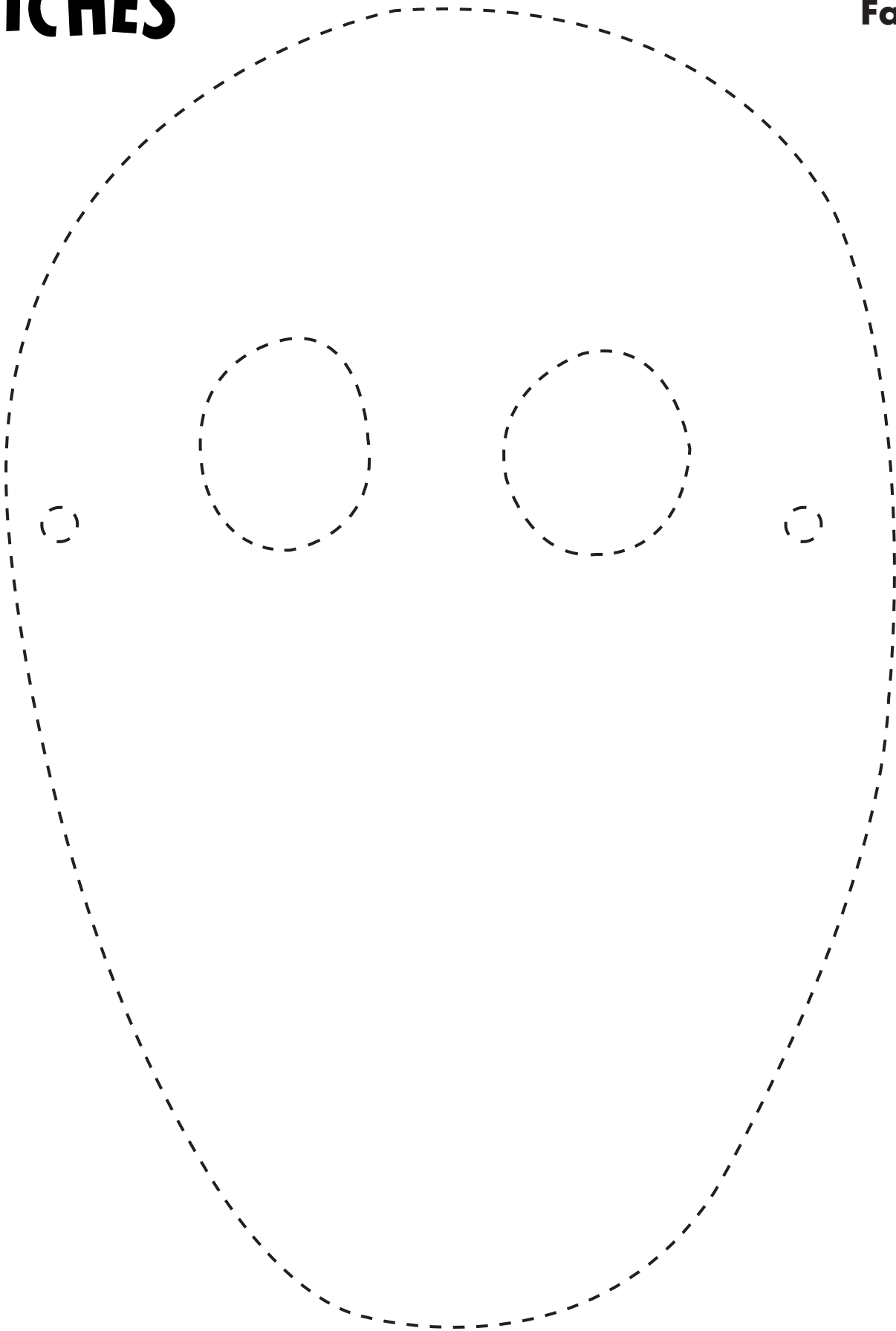
The Grand High Witch Face #1
