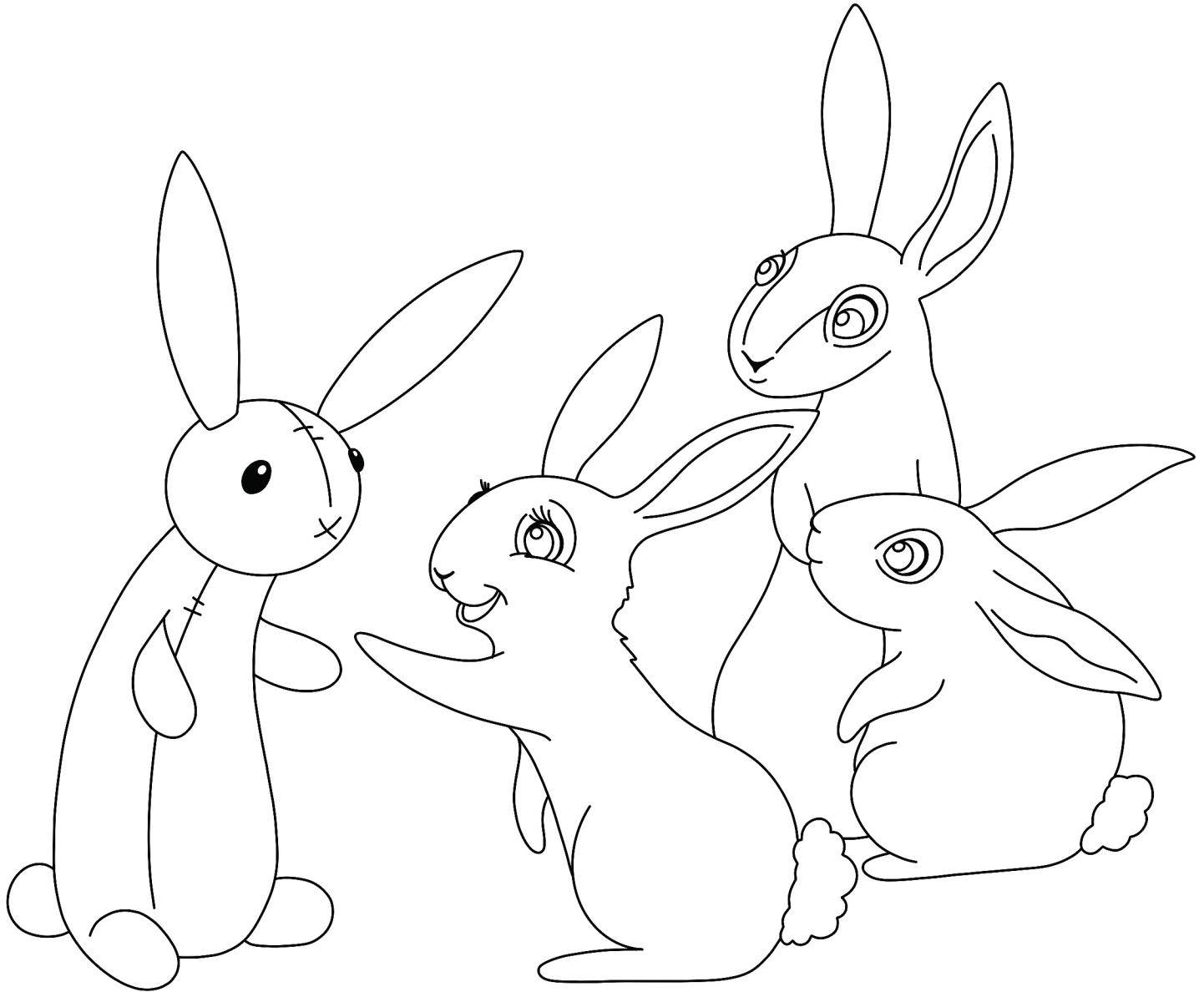

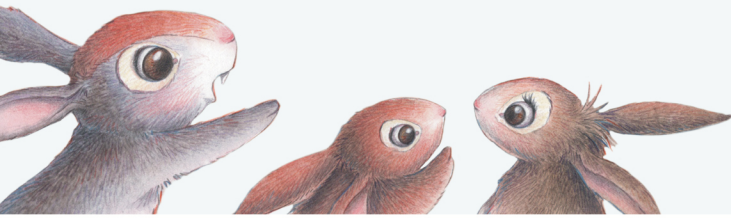

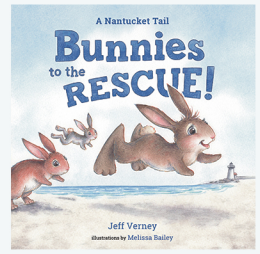

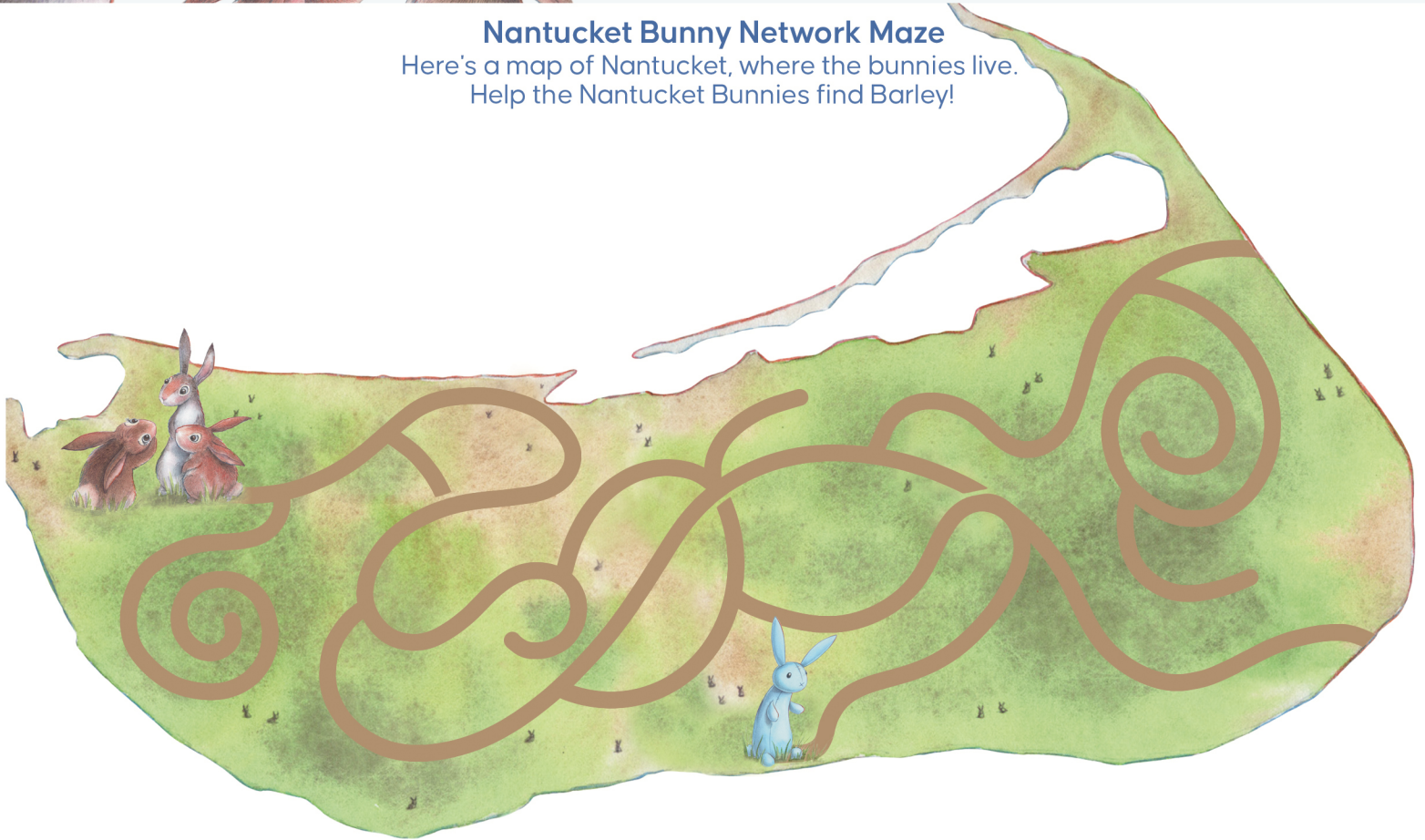

Glossary

Helping: When we ask and do something nice for someone who really needs it.
Helping is like being a good friend!

Assuming: When we guess what someone wants without asking them first.
Assuming is like deciding for someone else!
