**Remember:** The best Zawadi gifts come from the heart and show you've put thought and care into making something special for someone you love.


**Gift-Giving Tip:** Present your Zawadi during the Kwanzaa celebration and explain why you chose to make this particular gift for that person.

5. Nia (Purpose) - Having a reason for being and serving our community
6. Kuumba (Creativity) - Making our community beautiful and vibrant
7. Imani (Faith) - Believing in ourselves, each other, and our shared future
